





FOLLON the RATH

God fulfills God's promise to Moses before Moses dies by letting him see something special. What is it? Follow the path of letters, and each time you come to a capital letter, write that letter down at the bottom of the page. When you get to the end of the path, see what is spelled out below.





In Matthew 22, a lawyer asks Jesus what the greatest commandment is. Jesus replies with two—""You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the greatest and first commandment. And a second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself." In the two boxes, draw what you think each of these commandments could look like in your life—in the first box, draw how you love God. In the second box, draw how you could love your neighbor.
